REGULATIONS TO AMEND THE ELECTION PETITIONS REGULATIONS, 1930, WITH RESPECT TO THE PLACE FOR TRIAL OF ELECTION PETITIONS.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Election Petitions Regulations, 1934, and shall be construed with the Election Petitions Regulations, 1930, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations. Short Title.

2. Paragraph (2) of Regulation 20 of the Principal Regulations is hereby revoked and the following substituted therefor:— Amendment of Reg. 20 (2) of the Principal Regulations.

“(2) The trial shall take place in such county as the Chief Justice may direct at least fourteen days before the trial.”

Made by the Governor in Council this 24th day of July, 1934, by virtue of the authority conferred by the British Guiana (Constitution) Order in Council, 1928.
