## REGULATIONS TO PROVIDE FOR AN INCREASE IN THE AMOUNTS PAYABLE IN RESPECT OF PILOTAGE FEES UNDER THE HARBOURS AND PILOTAGE REGULATIONS, 1924.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Harbours and Pilotage (Temporary Surtax) Regulations, 1934, and shall be construed with the Harbours and Pilotage Regulations, 1924, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations and any amending Regulations. Short title.

2. In addition to the fees prescribed by Regulation 44 of the Principal Regulations as amended by the Harbours and Pilotage Regulations, 1929, for services rendered by pilots there shall be levied and collected during the year 1935, a surtax at the rate of fifteen per centum on every such fee: provided that the surtax shall not be levied in the case of any vessel while proceeding to or from the Essequibo River for or with lumber. Imposition of a surtax of 15 per cent. on pilotage fees.

3. The surtax imposed by these Regulations shall be paid and the payment thereof may be enforced as if the surtax were part of the fees prescribed by the Principal Regulations. Application of provisions of principal Regulations

4. These Regulations shall come into operation on the first day of January, Nineteen Hundred and Thirty-five. Commencement of Regulations.
