REGULATIONS TO PROVIDE FOR AN INCREASE IN THE AMOUNTS PAYABLE IN RESPECT OF PILOTAGE FEES UNDER THE HARBOURS AND PILOTAGE REGULATIONS, 1924.

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Harbours and Short Pilotage (Temporary Surtax) Regulations, 1937, and shall be construed with the Harbours and Pilotage Regulations, 1924, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations and any amending Regulations.
- 2. In addition to the fees prescribed by regulation 44 of the Imposition Principal Regulations, as amended by the Harbours and Pilotage of a surtax of 15 per Regulations, 1929, for services rendered by pilots, there shall be cent. on levied and collected during the year 1938, a surtax at the rate of pilotage fees, fifteen per centum on every such fee:

Provided that the surtax shall not be levied in the case of any vessel while proceeding to or from the Essequibo River for or with lumber.

Application of provisions of Principal Regulations.

3. The surtax imposed by these Regulations shall be paid and the payment thereof may be enforced as if the surtax were part of the fees prescribed by the Principal Regulations.

Commencement of Regulations.

4. These Regulations shall come into operation on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and thirty-eight.
