## REGULATIONS TO AMEND THE MEDICAL BOARD (ELECTION) REGULATIONS, 1937.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Medical Board (Election) Regulations, 1939, and shall be construed with the Medical Board (Election) Regulations, 1937, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations. Short title.

2. Regulation 3 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the addition of the following as paragraph (7) thereof :— Amendment  
to Reg. 3 of  
Principal  
Regulations.

“(7) The Secretary shall enclose in the letter of notification a voting paper in a form approved by the Board, and no vote shall be valid unless it is recorded on such voting paper.

If any person transmits to the Secretary more than one voting paper in respect of any election neither voting paper shall be included in the count.”
