# UNDER SECTION 99 OF THE POLICE ACT, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER:-

Citation and commencement. 1. These Regulations, which amend the Police Regulations,\* may be cited as the Police (Amendment) Regulations 1980, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st January, 1980.

Amendment of Regulation 71 of the Principal Regulations. 2. Regulation 71 of the Principal Regulations is amended by substituting the words "eleven dollars" for all the words appearing after the word "be".

Amendment of Regulation 73 of the Principal Regulations.

- 3. Paragraph (4) of regulation 73 of the Principal Regulations is repealed and the following paragraph substituted therefor:-
  - (4) An officer in charge of a county or district may order for each prisoner a special cooked meal described in the first column of the Schedule in which case the charge for such meal for the areas mentioned in the second, third, and fourth columns respectively, of the said Schedule shall not exceed the price specified in the respective columns.
