

BRITISH GUIANA.

REGULATIONS
made under
THE PUBLIC HOSPITALS ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 187).

UNDER SECTION 4 (2) OF THE PUBLIC HOSPITALS ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Hospital Fees (Amendment) Regulations, 1947, and shall be construed with the Hospital Fees Regulations, 1932, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations.

2. The special rates for in-patient treatment (applicable to all Public Officers and other Employees) set out in Schedule VII to the Principal Regulations, as amended by the Hospital Fees (Amendment) Regulations, 1946,* are hereby made applicable to all Employees of the Transport and Harbours Department.

3. Paragraph 2 of Schedule VI to the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion of sub-paragraph (9) therefrom.
