REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE MINING (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 175).

UNDER SECTION 98 OF THE MINING (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Mining (Amendment) Regulations, 1953, and shall be construed and read as one with the Mining Regulations, 1931, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and any Regulations amending the same.

2. Regulation 43A of the Principal Regulations, as inserted by Regulation 2 of the Mining (Amendment) Regulations (No. 2) 1938, is hereby amended by the insertion after sub-regulation (5) of the following—

“(6) Where the concession or lease is to mine or dredge for minerals the rent payable shall be at the rate of twenty cents per acre per annum.”
