REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE AUXILIARY FIRE BRIGADE ORDINANCE, 1952,

(No. 47 of 1952).

UNDER SECTION 17 OF THE AUXILIARY FIRE BRIGADE ORDINANCE, 1952, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE SUPERINTENDENT WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Auxiliary Fire Brigade (Amendment) Regulations, 1954, and shall be construed and read as one with the Auxiliary Fire Brigade Regulations, 1953*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations.

2. The Principal Regulations are hereby amended by the insertion after regulation 5 of the following regulation —

“5A. There shall be paid to every member of the Brigade for every official drill, lecture or exercise of the Brigade he attends the sum of 24 cents.”

3. Regulation 16 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended —

(a) by the deletion of the semicolon at the end of paragraph (a) of subregulation (1) and the addition after the last item in that paragraph of the figure, word and semicolon —

“1 Cap;” ;

(b) by the deletion of the full stop at the end of paragraph (b) of subregulation (1) and the addition after the last item in that paragraph of the following items —

“1 Helmet
1 Pair Overalls
1 Drill Book.”;

(c) by the deletion of the words and figure “of 7 volumes” in the third line of sub-regulation (2).
