MADE UNDER

THE FORESTS ORDINANCE, 1953.

(No. 15 of 1953).

UNDER SECTION 41 OF THE FORESTS ORDINANCE, 1953,
THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE
BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Forests (Amendment) Regulations, 1954, and shall be construed and read as one with the Forests Regulations, 1953, No. 38 of 1953 hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and any Regulations amending the same.

2. The First Schedule to the Principal Regulations is hereby amended—

- (a) by the deletion from the classes of Part I set out below of the timbers listed thereunder —

- (b) by the insertion under the classes of Part I set out below of the timbers listed thereunder —

(c) by the substitution for the items in Part II of the following items—

7.	Paling posts and round-wood spars 3" — 6" diameter	30c. per 100 lin. ft. or part thereof
8.	Paling posts and round wood spars 6"—10" diameter	50c. per 100 lin. ft. or part thereof
9.	Saplings or wattlees less than 3" diameter	15c. per 100 or part thereof
10.	Charcoal	6c. per 100 lbs. or part thereof
11.	Firewood and tonwood	30c. per cord or 12c. per ton or part thereof
12.	Mangrove bark	5c. per 100 lbs.
13.	Balata, rubber, gums and tonka beans	2c. per lb.
14.	Orchids exported	25c. each.
