REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE ANIMAL DISEASES ORDINANCE, 1936,
(No. 29 of 1936).

UNDER SECTION 36 OF THE ANIMAL DISEASES ORDINANCE, 1936, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Animal Diseases (Foot and Mouth Disease) (No. 2) (Amendment) Regulations, 1954, and shall be construed and read as one with the Animal Diseases (Foot and Mouth Disease) (No. 2) Regulations, 1954[†], hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations.

2. Anything contained in the provisions of regulation 2 of the Principal Regulations to the contrary notwithstanding, meats of animals whether fresh, frozen, chilled or dried may, with the permission of the Director of Agriculture, be brought from Maracanata and Wichabai into any other area of the Colony.

3. These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 25th November, 1954.
