REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE SUMMARY JURISDICTION (MAGISTRATES) ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 12).

UNDER SECTION 63 OF THE SUMMARY JURISDICTION (MAGISTRATES) ORDINANCE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Summary Jurisdiction (Magistrates') Money (Amendment) Regulations, 1960, and shall be construed and read with the Summary Jurisdiction (Magistrates') Money Regulations*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and any regulations amending the same.

2. The Principal Regulations are hereby amended —

- (a) by re-numbering regulation 17 as regulation 17(1); and
- (b) by the addition thereafter of the following paragraph —

“(2) Any writ or warrant sent for execution to another district or from one police station to another, shall be sent by registered post.”
