THE POST OFFICE SAVINGS BANK ORDINANCE.

(Chapter 133).

UNDER SECTION 14 OF THE POST OFFICE SAVINGS BANK ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Post Office Savings Bank (Amendment) Regulations, 1957, and shall be construed and read as one with the Post Office Savings Bank Regulations*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations.

2. Regulations 41 and 42 of the Principal Regulations are hereby amended by the substitution for the words "twenty dollars" appearing in those regulations of the words "thirty dollars."
