REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE SPECIAL REVISAL ORDINANCE, 1956,  
(No. 9 of 1956).

UNDER SECTION 18 OF THE SPECIAL REVISAL ORDINANCE, 1956,  
THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE  
GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Special Revisal (Distribution of Registers) Regulations, 1957.

2. In these Regulations—

“candidate” means a candidate duly nominated for election in any electoral district under the Representation of the People Ordinance, 1957;\*

“election officer”, “electoral district” and “official list of electors” have the meanings assigned to them in the Representation of the People Ordinance, 1957.

3. All election officers shall be entitled to as many copies of the Official lists of electors as they require and as are approved by the Chief Electoral Officer.

4. Every candidate shall be entitled to one full set of the official lists of electors for his electoral district free of cost.

5. Subject to the distribution hereinbefore provided for available official lists of electors shall be sold to candidates and to the general public at the rate of two cents for every hundred names or part thereof.
