

BRITISH GUIANA

REGULATIONS  
Made Under  
THE INCOME TAX ORDINANCE,  
(Chapter 299)

UNDER SECTION 56A (12) OF THE INCOME TAX ORDINANCE  
THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY  
THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Income Tax (Board of Review) (Remuneration) Regulations, 1957.

2. Members of the Board of Review appointed under the provisions of section 56A of the Income Tax Ordinance\*, as inserted by section 12 of the Income Tax (Amendment) Ordinance, 1956\*\*, shall receive remuneration at the rate of thirty dollars for the Chairman and twenty-five dollars for every other member of the Board for each day during which they are engaged in attending meetings of the Board.

3. Every member of the Board shall be paid any actual travelling and subsistence expenses incurred in travelling on duty as such member:

Provided that no travelling or subsistence expenses shall be payable in respect of travelling within the City of Georgetown and its environs.
