MADE UNDER

THE IMMIGRATION ORDINANCE,  
(Chapter 98).

UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 35 OF THE IMMIGRATION  
ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE  
BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Immigration (Personnel of the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development) Regulations, 1961.

2. It is hereby declared that the governors, executive directors, alternates, officers and employees of the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development shall not be prohibited immigrants for the purposes of the Immigration Ordinance.\*
