REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE COLONIAL MEDICAL SERVICE ORDINANCE,  
(Chapter 134).

UNDER SECTION 52 OF THE COLONIAL MEDICAL SERVICE ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE MEDICAL BOARD:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Sicknurses and Dispensers (Training and Examination) Regulations, 1961, and shall be construed and read with the Sicknurses and Dispensers (Training and Examination) Regulations\*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and any Regulations amending the same.

2. In these Regulations —

“the Board” means the Medical Board established under the Colonial Medical Service Ordinance.

3. The Board shall have power to appoint suitable persons to lecture on the subjects prescribed by the Principal Regulations for the training and examination of sicknurses and dispensers.

4. Fees shall be paid by the Board to the lecturers at the rate of five dollars for each lecture.
