

BRITISH GUIANA

REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE MINING ORDINANCE,  
(Chapter 196).

UNDER 83 OF THE MINING ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Mining (Amendment) Regulations, 1963, and shall be construed and read with the Mining Regulations\*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and any Regulations amending the same.

2. Regulation 2 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion of the semicolon appearing at the end of the definition of the expression "gold" and the insertion thereafter of the words "and gold imported into the Colony".
