REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE BRITISH GUIANA (REGISTRATION) ORDER, 1964.

UNDER SECTION 2 OF THE BRITISH GUIANA (REGISTRATION) ORDER, 1964, THE GOVERNOR IN HIS DISCRETION HAS MADE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Registration (Amendment) (No. 4) Regulations, 1964, and shall be construed and read with the Registration Regulations, 1964*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and any Regulations amending the same.

2. Regulation 13 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the addition of the following paragraph after paragraph (6) thereof —

“(7) Where any person has, by reason of any circumstance whatever, been compelled to remove from his place of ordinary residence to any other place, he shall be deemed, if he so elects, to be ordinarily resident in such other place for the purposes of these Regulations.”

3. These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 8th May, 1964.
