THE BRITISH GUIANA (CONSTITUTION) ORDERS
1961 AND 1964

THE REGISTRATION (AMENDMENT) (NO. 8) REGULATIONS
1964.

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED BY ARTICLE 47
OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AS SET OUT
IN SCHEDULE I TO THE BRITISH GUIANA (CONSTITU-
TION) ORDER 1964, AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER
POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, THE GOVER-
NOR IN HIS DISCRETION HAS MADE THE FOLLOWING
REGULATIONS —

1. These regulations may be cited as the Registration Citation.
(Amendment) (No. 8) Regulations, 1964 and shall be construed and
read with the Registration Regulations, 1964 and any regulations
amending the same.

2. The Registration Regulations 1964 are hereby amended by Insertion of
the insertion after regulation 42 thereof of the following new regulation— new
"Deletion of regulation
duplicate 42A.
entries." 42A.

42A. Where pursuant to regulation 39A an application
for transfer of registration has been granted but by in-
advertence the name of the applicant has not been deleted
from the preliminary list in which it was first entered and
in consequence appears in two parts of a register or in a
part of one register and a part of another register, the
Commission may at any time authorise the deletion of the
name and other particulars of the person concerned from
that part of the register in which it is wrongly entered
and the consequential amendment of any official list of
electors published under the Elections Regulations, 1964."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the regulations but is intended to indicate
their general purport)

It has come to light that the names of certain electors whose regis-
tration was transferred under regulation 39A of the Registration Regula-
tions were by inadvertence not deleted from the preliminary list of the
division from which their registration was transferred. In consequence
their names appear in two separate parts of the register and in two
official lists of electors. These regulations authorise the Elections Com-
mission to cause the necessary corrections to be made.
