BRITISH GUIANA

REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE EDUCATION ORDINANCE

(Chapter 91)

UNDER THE PROVISION OF SECTION 53 OF THE EDUCATION ORDINANCE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the **Government County Scholarships (Amendment) Regulations, 1959**, and shall be construed and read as one with the **Government County Scholarships Regulations 1957** hereinafter referred to as the **Principal Regulations**.

2. Regulation 3 of the **Principal Regulations** is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor :—

“3. Sixty-four **Government County Scholarships** shall be open for competition annually, namely :—

(a) **Twenty-one Demerara Scholarships** allocated as follows :—

(i) **Eight for the city of Georgetown—five for boys and three for girls;**

(ii) **Thirteen for Rural Demerara—seven for boys and six for girls;**

(b) **Sixteen Berbice Scholarships—nine for boys and seven for girls;**

(c) **Twelve Essequibo Scholarships—seven for boys and five for girls;**

(d) **Fifteen General Scholarships.**
