REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 132).

UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 97 OF THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE DIRECTOR OF POSTS AND TELECOMMUNICATIONS WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Telephone (Amendment) Regulations, 1959.

2. Regulation 15 of the Telephone Regulations*, is hereby amended by the renumbering of the regulation as regulation 15(1), and by the insertion thereafter of the following paragraph:—

“(2) In addition to the charges payable under paragraph (1) hereof, an installation fee of \$1.00 shall be payable in respect of each line connected on every private branch exchange installed.”
