### THE PESTICIDES AND TOXIC CHEMICALS CONTROL ACT

(Cap. 68:09)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 32 OF THE PESTICIDES AND TOXIC CHEMICALS CONTROL ACT, AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE PESTICIDES AND TOXIC CHEMICALS CONTROL BOARD, I MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:-

Citation.

Reg No. 8 of 2004

1. These Regulations, which amend the Pesticides and Toxic Chemicals Regulations, may be cited as the Pesticides and Toxic Chemicals (Amendment) Regulations 2019.

Amendment of regulation 14 of the Principal Regulations.

2. Regulation 14 of the Principal Regulations is amended as follows –  
(a) by the deletion of subregulations (3) and (5); and  
(b) by the renumbering of subregulation (4) as subregulation (3).

Amendment of regulation 80 of the Principal Regulations.

3. The Principal Regulations is amended by the substitution for regulation 80, of the following –

“80. A person shall not handle or apply restricted pesticides unless he has been suitably trained and is certified by the Board as a commercial applicator.”

Repeal of the First Schedule to the Principal Regulation.

4. The First Schedule to the Principal Regulations is repealed.

Repeal of the Second Schedule to the Principal Regulation.

5. The Second Schedule to the Principal Regulations is repealed.

Amendment of the Third Schedule to the Principal Regulation.


6. The Third Schedule to the Principal Regulations is amended by the substitution for that Schedule of the following Schedule –

**“Third Schedule**

**Fee Structure for Pesticides and Toxic Chemicals**

TYPE OF FEE	FEE
Registration for Pest Control Operator	- Two hundred thousand dollars per annum.
Import Licence	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- In relation to a pesticide, a fee of an amount equivalent to three percent of the value (including the cost, insurance and freight) of that pesticide; and</li> <li>- In relation to a toxic chemicals, a fee of an amount equivalent to one and a half percent of the value (including cost, insurance and freight) of that toxic chemicals.</li> </ul>
Pesticide or Toxic Chemical Vendor Licence	- Five thousand dollars per annum.
Maximum Residue Limit	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Twenty five thousand dollars per sample for screening for pesticides residues by Gas Chromatography/Mass Spectrometry (GC/MS);</li> <li>- Thirty five thousand dollars per sample for screening for pesticide residue by Liquid Chromatography (LC/QQQ);</li> <li>- Ten thousand dollars for the quantification per pesticide per sample after screening is done and</li> </ul>

	<p>samples found to be contaminated; and</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Forty Thousand dollars per sample for analysis of pesticides by Liquid Chromatography/Mass Spectrometry (LC/MS)."</li></ul>
