| Citation and Commencement | 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Mining (Special) Regulations 2006, and shall come into effect on the 8 th December 2005 and shall cease to have effect upon the expiration of licences granted under these Regulations. | | | | | | | | | | | | |
| Application | 2. These Regulations shall apply only for the purposes of and in relation to the application and grant for Special Mining Permits over the areas as described in Schedule 1 hereunder and to the extent only as set out in these Regulations. | | | | | | | | | | | | |
| Application for Special Mining Permits | 3. (i) Application for Special Mining Permits for areas stated in Schedule 1, shall be made mutatis mutandis in accordance With the provision stated in Clause 43(3) of the Mining Act No. 20 of 1989.

(ii) Applications for Special Mining Permit over the areas set out in Schedule 1 shall be specific only to bauxite. | | | | | | | | | | | | |
| Grant of Special Mining Permit | 4. (i) In relation to the grant of Special Mining Permits for areas set out in Schedule 1, such Permits shall be of a maximum of three years duration and are renewable once only for a duration of one year.

SCHEDULE 1**20 Green Creek**

Tract A being a portion of state land known as Green Creek and being a portion of mining lease 581 situate on the right bank of Berbice River and commences at a galvanise pipe set in concrete bases etched D.E.R, 2400 feet west of the intersection of two roads marked A and B and 128 feet north of center line of road A as shown on the said plan and its boundaries extend thence N 10⁰ 35' 19" (T) 2015.04 feet thence N 350⁰ 43' 58" (T) 1090.46 feet thence N 307⁰ 11' 12" (T) 1052.86 feet thence N 248⁰ 02' 27" (T) 952.42 feet, thence N 180⁰ 39' 17" (T) 2156.69 feet thence N 161⁰ 07' 38" (T) 1495.78 feet, thence N 77⁰ 36' 24" (T) 1093.74 feet to point of commencement and containing an area of 136.910 acres.

16 Bissaruni

Tract C being a portion of state land known as Bissaruni 16,400 feet east of mining leases 581 situate on the right bank of Berbice River and commences at a galvanise pipe set in concrete based etched D.W.R, and 346 feet east of the intersection point of Bissaruni Creek and a road marked G and 245 feet along a bearing of N 348 49' 56" (T) from the center line of the said road and marked G as shown on this plan and its boundaries extend thence N 348⁰ 49' 56" (T) 597.69 feet, thence N 96⁰ 42' 02" (T) 474.00 feet thence N 356⁰ 37' 20" (T) 152.46 feet thence N 89⁰ 16' 07" (T) 925.30 feet, thence N 181⁰ 25' 57" (T) 222.59 feet, thence N 87⁰ 46' 29" (T) 550.07 feet, thence N 150⁰ 26' 44" (T) 472.76 feet, thence N 180⁰ 21' 08" (T) 195.57 feet, thence N 134⁰ 52' 57" (T) 296.14 feet, thence N 179⁰ 36' 29" (T) 488.61 feet, thence N 226⁰ 47' 16" (T) 519.52 feet, thence N 179⁰ 45' 22" (T) 454.96 feet, thence N 227⁰ 36' 57" (T) 278.77 feet, thence N 264⁰ 18' 12" (T) 1952.51 feet, thence N 02⁰ 17' 49" (T) 1776.95 feet to a point of commencement and containing an area of 114.764 acres.

22 Souwari

Tract B being a point of state land known as Souwari and being a part of mining lease 581 situate on the right bank of Berbice River and commences at a galvanise pipe set in concrete based etched D.W.R, 1600 feet east of the intersection of three roads marked C, D and E and 987 feet south of center line of road E as shown on the said plan, and its boundaries extend thence N 01⁰ 04' 40" (T) 1153.82 feet thence N 72⁰ 30' 52" (T) 1089.82 feet, thence N 96⁰ 41' 26" (T) 1187.65 feet thence N 187⁰ 03' 04" (T) 1399.62 feet thence N 271⁰ 17' 29" (T) 2069.40 feet to a point of commencement and containing an area of 68.506 acres.
