**Regulations  
Made Under  
The Mining Act  
(No. 20 of 1989)**

**In exercise of the Powers Conferred upon the Minister by Section 10 the Mining Act, 1989, I hereby make the following Regulations.**

- Citation and commencement 1. This Order may be cited as the GGMC Prospecting for Gold, Valuable Minerals Precious Stones, Precious Metals, Base Metals, and Industrial Minerals Rescission Order 2006 and shall come into effect on the 15<sup>th</sup> August 2006.
- Reservation 2. The reservation of the areas described herein below is hereby rescinded and the areas described in the schedule below are hereby declared to be unoccupied state land.
3. Persons may apply for the award and issuance of Prospecting Licences over the area as set out in the schedule during the period 15<sup>th</sup> August 2006 to 15<sup>th</sup> November 2006.

Thereafter, the area would be open for application for any mineral licence.

**SCHEDULE 1**

Tract of state land located in the Rupununi No.6, Potaro No.2 and Mazaruni No.3 Mining Districts, as shown on Terra Surveys Topographic Map 23NW, 23SE, 24SW, 24NW, 24SE, 32NE, 32SE, 33NW, 33SE, 33SW, 34SW, 42NW, 42NE, 42SW, 43SW, 43NW, 48NE, 48SE, 49NW, 49NE, 49SE, 49SW, 50NW, and 54NW within the following boundaries:

Commencing from Point 1, located at geographical coordinates of longitude 60°34'0"W and latitude 6°11'34"N, thence at true bearing of 142°, for a distance of approximately 48 miles 311 yards, to Point 2, located at geographical coordinates of longitude 60°8'18"W and latitude 5°38'27"N, thence at true bearing of 120°, for a distance of

approximately **47 miles 363 yards**, to **Point 3**, located at geographical coordinates of longitude **59°32'41"W** and latitude **5°17'52"N**, thence along the eastern boundary of the Kaieteur National Park for a distance of approximately 41 miles, to **Point 4**, located at geographical coordinates of longitude **59°26'33"W** and latitude **5°2'35"N**, thence at true bearing of **211°**, for a distance of approximately **46 miles 617 yards**, to **Point 5**, located at geographical coordinates of longitude **59°47'19"W** and latitude **4°28'3"N**, thence along the Guyana / Brazil Border for a distance of approximately 109 miles, to **Point 6**, located at geographical coordinates of longitude **60°0'0"W** and latitude **5°6'0"N**, thence at true bearing of **0°**, for a distance of approximately **27 miles 1121 yards**, to **Point 7**, located at geographical coordinates of longitude **60°0'0"W** and latitude **5°30'0"N**, thence at true bearing of **270°**, for a distance of approximately **38 miles 1711 yards**, to **Point 8**, located at geographical coordinates of longitude **60°34'0"W** and latitude **5°30'0"N**, thence at true bearing of **0°**, for a distance of approximately **47 miles 1528 yards**, to the point of commencement at **Point 1**.

Thus enclosing an area of approximately **1,987,840 acres**, save and except all lands lawfully held or occupied.
