REGULATIONS

Made Under

THE NATIONAL INSURANCE AND SOCIAL SECURITY ACT

(Cap. 36:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTIONS 21 and 51 OF THE NATIONAL INSURANCE AND SOCIAL SECURITY ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:—

1. These Regulations, which amend the National Insurance and Social Security (Claims and Payments) Regulations*, may be cited as the National Insurance and Social Security (Claims and Payments) (Amendment) Regulations 1992.

Citation.

2. Regulation 14 (1) (a) of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended in the following respects —

Amendment of regulation 14 of the Principal Regulations.

- (a) by the substitution for the word “ten” of the word “fourteen”;
- (b) by the substitution for the semi-colon at the end thereof of a colon and by the insertion immediately thereafter of the following proviso —

“Provided that the General Manager may in just cases where it could be shown that the reason for not submitting the claim within the prescribed time was due to difficulty arising from the distant geographical location of the claimant’s home or workplace from the nearest National Insurance Office, extend that period to one which is considered reasonable taking into consideration the circumstances of the case but any such extension shall not be for more than six months from the earliest day in respect of which the claim was made;”.
