REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ACT

(Cap. 47:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 97 OF THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:—

1. These Regulations, which amend the Private Letter Boxes Regulations*, may be cited as the Private Letter Boxes (Amendment) Regulations 1994, and shall come into operation on 1st February, 1994.

7. Regulation 7(1) of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "from the date on which the use of the box commences" of the words, "on the 1st January, of each year",

9. Regulation 9 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "one hundred and twenty-five dollars" of the words "two hundred dollars".

10. Regulation 10 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for all the words beginning with "The renter" and ending with "delivered to him", of the words "The renter shall pay to the Postmaster General the replacement cost of the new lock and shall be required to make a new deposit of two hundred dollars on each new key for a private letter box delivered to him".

22. Regulation 22 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution thereof, of the following regulation —

“22. The charges for the rental of private boxes shall be as follows:

All Post Offices	1	\$1000.00
All Post Offices	2	\$1500.00
