THE FOREST ACT

(Cap. 67:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 42 OF THE FORESTS ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:—

1.(1) These Regulations, which amend the Forest Regulations*, may be cited as the Forest (Amendment) Regulations 1996

Citation and commencement.

(2) The amendments to regulation 7(3) and 7A(3), shall in accordance with the Interpretation and General Clauses Act, come into force on the date of publication of these Regulations.

Cap. 2:01

- (3) The prescribed rates of royalty in the First Schedule shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st July, 1996.
- (4) The prescribed rates of fees in the Ninth Schedule, except those prescribed in paragraph 6, shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st July, 1996.
- (5) The prescribed rates of fees in pararaph 6 of the Ninth Schedule shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st April, 1996.

*Cap. 67:01 Subsidiary Legislation.

Amendment of regulation 7 of A the Principal Regulations.

- 2. Regulation 7(3) of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution therefor of the following—
 - "7. (3) The Commissioner may require any applicant for a lease to enter into a bond with or without sureties in any sum not less than \$250,000 or a sum equivalent to one year's minimum royalty or to the royalty payable on one year's anticipated production whichever is the greater, conditioned for the due fulfilment by the applicant of all the terms and conditions of the lease and for the due payment of all fees and rayalties."

Amendment of regulation 7A of the Principal Regulations.

- 3. Regulation 7A(3) of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution therefor of the following .
 - "7A.(3) The Commissioner may require any applicant for a timber sales agreement to enter nto a bond with or without sureties in any sum not less than \$500,000 or a sum equivalent to one year's minimum royalty or to the royalty payable on one year's anticipated production, whichever is the greater, conditioned for the due fulfilment by the applicant of all the terms and conditions of the timber sales agreement and for the due payment of all fees and royalties."

Substitution of First and Ninth Schedules. 4. The First and Ninth Schedules to the Principal Regulations are hereby amended by the substitution therefor of the First Schedule A and the Ninth Schedule in Schedule B, respectively—
