THE STATISTICS ACT

(Cap. 19:09)

UNDER SECTION 15 OF THE STATISTICS ACT AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING ME IN THAT BEHALF, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Statistics (Labour Force Census) (Flousehold) Regulations 1997.
 - 2. In these Regulations -

- (a) "Census" means the Census directed to be taken by Statistics (Labour Force Census) (Household) Order 1997:
 - (b) "householder" means any occupier who manages any dwelling house.

3. The particulars to be supplied by a householder or a member of a household, as the case may be, on taking of the Census, shall be in respect of the matters specified in regulation 4 of these Regulations and shall be supplied in such form and detail as the Statistician may direct.

Information to be supplied by householder.

- 4. Every house holder, on the taking of the Census, shall when resuired to do so by the Statistician or any authorised officer; furnish the following information
 - (a) the name, address, age, educational attainment, marital status, principal occupation, sex. ethnicity and relationship to head, of any member of his household;
 - (b) the salary, wages, allowances, bonuses, fees, and any other remuneration received by any member of his household;
 - (c) the status of economic activity during the past twelve months and current economic activity during the reference week of the survey of any member of his bousehold;
 - (d) the demographic, educational, skill and occupational profiles of members of his household who have migrated during the past 365 days preceding the survey;
 - (e) such other information as the Statistician or authorised officer may consider necessary for the purposes of the Census:

Provided that where it is not practicable to obtain from the householder any information required to be furnished in respect of any member of his household, the Statistician or authorised officer shall require that member of the household to furnish the information.
