THE FORESTS ACT
(Cap. 67:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 42 OF THE FORESTS ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:—

1. These Regulations, which amend the Forests Regulations*, may be cited as the Forests (Amendment) Regulations 1985. Citation.
2. Regulation 7 (3) of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "not exceeding \$500" of the words "not less than \$1,000". Amendment of regulation 8 of the Principal Regulations.
3. Regulation 7 A(3) of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "not exceeding \$500" of the words "not less than \$25,000". Amendment of regulation 7A of the Principal Regulations.
4. Regulation 8 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion after paragraph (4), of the following paragraph as paragraph (5) — Amendment of regulation 8 of the Principal Regulations.

“(5) Every lessee or permittee of a wood-cutting tract or any other person who desires to have permission for any of the transport privileges under this regulation shall make application therefor to the Commission and shall pay in respect thereof the prescribed fee.”
5. The Principal Regulations are hereby amended by the insertion after regulation 10, of the following regulation as regulation 10A — Insertion of new regulation 10A of the Principal Regulations.

“Licences for charcoal and firewood dealers. 10A.(1) Every person who desires to carry on the business of purchasing charcoal or firewood for resale shall make application to the Commission for a licence so to do and shall pay in respect thereof the prescribed fee.”

(2) Every such licence shall be in the form set out in the Seventh Schedule and shall continue in force until the 31st December of the year in which it is issued.

(3) No person shall carry on the business of purchasing charcoal or firewood for resale unless he is the holder of a licence issued under this regulation.”.

6. Regulation 27 (4) of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for the words beginning with “sixty” and ending with “pit” of the following words —

“the sum of three hundred dollars and one hundred dollars for a saw pit”.
