REGULATIONS

Made Under

THE PUBLIC HEALTH ORDINANCE
(Cap. 145)

UNDER SECTIONS 65 (c) AND (d) AND 157 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE CENTRAL BOARD OF HEALTH WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE PRESIDENT :—

Citation.

1. These Regulations, which amend the Cremation (Pyre System) Regulation 1955*, may be cited as the Cremation (Pyre System) (Amendment) Regulation 1985.

Amendment of regulation 11 of the Principal Regulations.

2. Regulation 11 of the Principal Regulation is hereby amended by the substitution for the word "twenty-four" of the word "twelve".

Amendment of regulation 12 of the Principal Regulations.

3. Regulation 12 of the Principal Regulation is hereby amended as follows :—

- (a) by the insertion after the word "coffin" where it occurs for the first time of the words "or on a bier";
- (b) by the insertion after the word "coffin" where it occurs for the second time of the word "or bier"; and
- (c) by the substitution for the full stop at the end thereof of a colon and by the insertion of the following proviso at the end thereof —

"Provided that the Chairman of the Board may, for reasons of public health, when granting approval for the cremation of the human remains of any person, direct that the corpse shall be transported to the crematorium only in a closed coffin and where any such direction is given the corpse shall be transported to the crematorium only in a closed coffin."
