## REGULATIONS

Made Under

## THE FACTORIES ACT

(Cap. 95:02)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 26 OF THE FACTORIES ACT. I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:—

1. These Regulations, which amend the Factories (Health and Welfare) Regulations\*, may be cited as the Factories (Health and Welfare) (Amendment) Regulations 1983. Citation.
2. Regulation 2 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion of the word "male" from the definition of "young person". Amendment of Regulation 2 of the Principal Regulations.
3. Regulation 16 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "and no female". Amendment of regulation 16 of the Principal Regulations.
4. Regulation 17 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended in the following respects — Amendment of regulation 17 of the Principal Regulations.
  - (a) (i) in paragraph (1) by the deletion of the words "or any female;"
  - (ii) in paragraph (b) of the proviso to paragraph (1) by the deletion of the words "or female"; and
  - (b) in paragraph (2) by the deletion of the words "and female".
5. Regulation 18 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "and females". Amendment of regulation 18 of the Principal Regulations.
6. The Schedule to the Principal Regulations is hereby amended as follows— Amendment of Schedule to the Principal Regulations.
  - (a) by the deletion of the words "women and";
  - (b) by the deletion of column 2;
  - (c) by renumbering columns (3) to (8) (inclusive) as (2) to (7) respectively; and
  - (d) by the substitution in column (6) as renumbered for the words "Columns (5) and (6)" of the words "Columns (4) and (5)".
