THE NATIONAL INSURANCE AND SOCIAL SECURITY ACT

(Cap. 36:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER BY SECTIONS 11, 15, 48 AND 51 OF THE NATIONAL INSURANCE AND SOCIAL SECURITY ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:—

1. These Regulations, which amend the National Insurance and Common Social Security (Persons Abroad and Voluntary Contributors) Regulations*, may be cited as the National Insurance and Social Security (Persons Abroad and Voluntary Contributors) (Amendment) Regulations 1990.

2. Regulation 2 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for the definition of "insurable income" of the following definition -

Administration of the control of the

""insurable income" means the weekly or monthly income on which contributions are paid by an insured person and is subject to an upper limit which is determined by the Board on the basis of four times the weekly or monthly minimum wage prevailing in the public service.'
