FIRST LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL.

SECOND SESSION.

RESOLUTION No. XLIX.

THAT, with reference to Governor's Message No. 11 of 1930, this Council approves of the acceptance by Government of a loan of £12,100 from the Colonial Development Fund for the re-opening of the Bartica-Kaburi road, together with a free grant of £3,000 for the purchase of three suitable motor lorries to operate on this road; the loan to be free of interest for five years, carrying interest thereafter at 5% and to be repayable within a total period of twenty-five years, or on the flotation of a further development loan, whichever is earlier, and that this Council respectfully requests His Excellency the Officer Administering the Government to submit to the Colonial Development Committee an application for an additional sum of money sufficient to construct an extension of the said portion of the Bartica-Kaburi road to Tumatumari and thence to Kaieteur on the Potaro River with a branch road from Kangaruma to Karanang on the Mazaruni, and that a Committee of five persons consisting of not less than three Elected Members be appointed by His Excellency the Officer Administering the Government finally to determine the route and terminus of the said road and its branches, and to decide as to the supervision and control of the construction of the said road.
