UNIFICATION CHURCH (INCORPORATION) BILL 1974

ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS

SECTION

1. Short title.
2. Interpretation.
3. Incorporation of the Executive Committee.

A BILL

Intituled

An act to incorporate the Unification Church.

A. D. 1974. Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:—

Short title. 1. This Act may be cited as the Unification Church (Incorporation) Act 1974.

Inter-pretation. 2. In this Act —

“the Church” means the Unification Church in Guyana;  
 “Executive Committee” means the Executive Committee of the Church constituted in accordance with the provisions of this Act;

“President” means any person holding the office of President of the Church;

“Secretary” means any person holding the office of Secretary of the Church;

“Treasurer” means any person holding the office of Treasurer of the Church;

“Vice-President” means any person holding the office of Vice-President of the Church.

Committee. 3. The President, the Vice-President, the Treasurer, the Secretary and two other members of the Church who shall be selected by a majority of the members of the Church, shall be a body corporate and shall have the name of the Executive Committee of the Unification Church in Guyana.

Committee. 4. No change in the membership of the Executive Committee shall derogate from the title or powers of the said Committee in respect of any property or interest therein.

Committee. 5. A statement that any person named therein is a member of the Executive Committee, purporting to be signed by the President or Vice-President and Secretary of the Executive Committee shall be **prima facie** evidence of the said fact.

6. All property, whether movable or immovable, which may hereafter be acquired by the Executive Committee shall be held by the Executive Committee for the use and benefit of the Church.

Service of  
process.

7. All process which is required to be served on the Executive Committee shall be deemed to be sufficiently served —

- (a) If a copy thereof is left with the President at any place in Guyana or with an adult inmate at the place of residence of the President; or
- (b) if a copy thereof is published in the Gazette.

#### EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to incorporate in Guyana, certain persons as the Executive Committee of the Unification Church in Guyana.
