AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE GLADTIDINGS ASSEMBLY
GUYANA MISSION.

A. D. 1975 Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:—

Short title. 1. This Act may be cited as the Gladtidings Assembly Guyana Mission (Incorporation) Act 1975.

Interpre-
tation. 2. In this Act —
“the Church” means the Gladtidings Assembly Guyana Mission;

“the Executive Committee” means the Executive Committee of the Church constituted in accordance with the provisions of this Act;

“the President” means any person holding the office of President of the Church;

“the Secretary” means any person holding the office of Secretary of the Church;

“the Treasurer” means any person holding the office of Treasurer of the Church;

“the Vice-President” means any person holding the office of Vice-President of the Church.

Incorpora-
tion of
Executive
Committee. 3. The President, the Vice-President, the Secretary, the Treasurer and two members who shall be chosen by a majority of the members of the Church, shall be a body corporate and shall have the name of the Executive Committee of the Gladtidings Assembly Guyana Mission.

Committee. 4. No change in the membership of the Executive Committee shall derogate from the powers of the said Committee in respect of any property or any interest therein.

5. A statement that any person named therein is a member of the Executive Committee purporting to be signed by the President or Vice-President and Secretary shall be prima facie evidence of the said fact. Evidence of appointment as member of Executive Committee.

6. All property whether movable or immovable which may hereafter be acquired by the Executive Committee by virtue of the provisions of this Act, shall be held by the Executive Committee for the use and benefit of the Church. Tenure of property for the use and benefit of the Church.

7. All process which is required to be served on the Executive Committee shall be deemed to be sufficiently served— Service of process.

- (a) if a copy thereof is left with the President at any place in Guyana or with an adult residing at the place of residence of the President; or
- (b) if a copy thereof is published in the Gazette.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to incorporate in Guyana, certain persons as the Executive Committee of the Glad Tidings Assembly Guyana Mission.
