TAHRIK-I-JADID AHMADIYYA MUSLIM MISSION OF GUYANA  
(INCORPORATION) BILL 1976

Intituled

AN ACT to provide for the incorporation of a Body to be known as the Tahrik-i-Jadid Ahmadiyya Muslim Mission in Guyana.

Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Tahrik-i-Jadid Ahmadiyya Muslim Mission of Guyana (Incorporation) Act 1976.

Incorporation of the Mission.

2. Sher Mohammad Ibrahim Khan, President, Rashid Ferdinand, Vice President, Mohamed Sherrief Baksh, General Secretary, Azeem Khan, Assistant General Secretary, Hassan Baksh, Treasurer, John Mohamed Alladin, Member, Mohamed Ameen Sultan, Member, Shafee Mokhan, Member, Mohammad Aslam Qureshi, Missionary, and their successors in office, shall be a body corporate and shall have the name of the Tahrik-i-Jadid Ahmadiyya Muslim Mission of Guyana (hereinafter referred to as "the Mission").

Aims and objects of the Mission.

3. The aims and objects of the Mission are as follows —

- (a) to propagate the truth of Islam as interpreted in Ahmadiyyat;
- (b) to provide instruction for children and adults with a view to their religious, moral, intellectual, social and physical advancement;
- (c) to establish and maintain libraries for the use of members of the Mission and the public;
- (d) to arrange lectures and discussions on religious subjects; and
- (e) to do all other lawful things conducive to the attainment of the aims and objects of the Mission.

Appointment of the Missionary.

4. The Missionary shall be the person appointed to that office (whether before or after the enactment of this Act) by the Khalifatul-Massih, Head of the Ahmadiyya Movement, and the function of the Missionary shall be to preach and teach the message of Ahmadiyyat and to ensure that the Mission adheres to that message in the exercise of its functions.

5. Subject to any law and the rules of the Mission for the time being in force, the Mission shall have such other powers as are appropriate for the attainment of its aims and objects. <sup>Powers of the Mission.</sup>

6. The Mission may make rules for the proper conduct of its proceedings and the discharge of its functions. <sup>Rules.</sup>

7. All deeds, and all other documents requiring the seal of the Mission, shall be sealed with the common seal of the Mission in the presence of the President, the General Secretary, and the Missionary, of the Mission, who shall sign every such deed or other document to which the common seal is affixed, and such signing shall be prima facie evidence that the seal was duly and properly affixed and that the seal is the lawful seal of the Mission. <sup>Mode of execution of documents.</sup>

8. All process which is required to be served on the Mission shall be deemed to be sufficiently served by leaving a copy thereof at, or by sending it by registered post to, the address in Guyana of the Mission. <sup>Service of process on the Mission.</sup>

#### EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM
