AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE PILGRIM HOLINESS CHURCH ORDINANCE.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana :—

A.D. 1965.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Pilgrim Holiness Church (Amendment) Ordinance, 1965 and shall be construed and read as one with the Pilgrim Holiness Church Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance. Short title.
Cap. 224.
2. The Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution of the words "Secretary of World Missions" for the words "General Missionary Superintendent" wherever they occur. Amendment of
Chapter 224.
3. Any reference to the General Missionary Superintendent in any other enactment, instrument or document of any kind shall be construed as a reference to the Secretary of World Missions. Consequential
changes.
4. Nothing in this Ordinance shall be deemed to affect any right of Her Majesty the Queen, Her Heirs and Successors, or of any body politic or coporate or of any other person or persons except such as are mentioned in this Ordinance and those claiming by, from, through or under them. Saving the

Her Majesty.

OBJECTS AND REASONS

Under the provisions of the Pilgrim Holiness Church Ordinance, Chapter 224, the General Missionary Superintendent of the General Board of Foreign Missions of the Pilgrim Holiness Church Corporation is deemed to be in British Guiana a body corporate known as the Pilgrim Holiness Church. It has been decided by the General Conference of the Pilgrim Holiness Church Corporation that the name of the Secretary of World Missions should be substituted for that of the General Missionary Superintendent and this Bill seeks to provide for this.
