UNIVERSITY OF GUYANA (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1965.

A BILL

Intituled

An Ordinance to amend the University of Guyana Ordinance, 1963

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

A.D. 1965

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the University of Guyana (Amendment) Ordinance, 1965, and shall be construed and read as one with the University of Guyana Ordinance, 1963, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

Short title.

2. Section 12 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended in the following respects—

Amendment of section 12 of the Principal Ordinance.

- (a) by the insertion between the words "shall" and "hold" in subsection (3) of the words and commas, "subject to the provisions of subsection (4) of this section,";
- (b) by renumbering subsections (4), (5), (6) and (7) as subsections (5), (6), (7) and (8) respectively; and
- (c) by the insertion of the following subsection as subsection (4) —

"(4) A member of the Board of Governors appointed by the Council of Ministers shall be liable to be removed from office at the pleasure of the Council of Ministers."

OBJECTS AND REASONS

Section 12 of the University of Guyana Ordinance, 1963, provides for the composition of the Board of Governors of the University of Guyana. The Council of Ministers have power to appoint not more than ten persons as members of the Board who may hold office for such periods as are specified in their instruments of appointment but not exceeding three years. There is no provision (as is the case in other enactments) enabling any such appointment to be revoked at any time prior to the expiration of the period of the appointment. Clause 2 of this Bill seeks to amend section 12 of the Ordinance to enable this to be done.
