AN ORDINANCE FURTHER TO AMEND THE FACTORIES
REGULATIONS (VALIDATION) ORDINANCE, 1955.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Factories Regulations (Validation) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1957, and shall be construed and read as one with the Factories Regulations (Validation) Ordinance, 1955, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.
