Bill No. 1 of 1956

A BILL
INTITULED

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE LAW REVISION ORDINANCE, 1949.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Law Revision (Amendment) Ordinance, 1956, and shall be construed and read as one with the Law Revision Ordinance, 1949, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

Short title.

2. Subsection (3) of section thirteen of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "such date as aforesaid" of the words "the date referred to in subsection (1) of section three".

Amendment of section 13 of the Principal Ordinance.

OBJECTS AND REASONS

The object of this Bill is to remove doubts regarding the coming into force of the revised edition of the Ordinances and of the subsidiary laws of the Colony prepared under the provisions of the Law Revision Ordinance, 1949.
