A BILL  
INTITULEDAN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE TAX ORDINANCE WITH  
RESPECT TO SPIRIT SHOP LICENCES.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Tax (Amendment) Ordinance, 1956, and shall be construed and read as one with the Tax Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance and any Ordinance amending the same.

Short title.

Cap. 298.

2. Section 42 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution of a comma for the full-stop at the end of the section, and by the addition of the following thereafter —  
“and if it is situate elsewhere in the Colony the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars.”
