

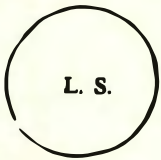

INSTRUMENT APPOINTING A PARLIAMENTARY SECRETARY.

WHEREAS it is provided by paragraph (1) of article 43 of the Constitution of Guyana that the Governor-General, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, may appoint Parliamentary Secretaries from among members of the National Assembly to assist Ministers in the discharge of their functions:

AND WHEREAS, George Bowman Esquire, M.P., was appointed a Parliamentary Secretary to assist the Minister of Labour in the discharge of the responsibilities assigned to him in pursuance of article 36 of the said Constitution, with effect from the 1st September, 1966.

NOW THEREFORE, in pursuance of the said provisions and acting on the advice of the Acting Prime Minister, I do hereby appoint the said George Bowman Esquire, M.P., Parliamentary Secretary, to assist the Minister of Agriculture and Natural Resources in the discharge of the responsibilities assigned to him in pursuance of article 36 of the said Constitution with effect from the 1st March, 1967.
