**Intituled**

AN ACT to provide for the issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sums necessary to meet the expenditure (not otherwise lawfully charged on the Consolidated Fund) of Guyana for the fiscal year ending 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2009, estimates whereof have been approved by the National Assembly, and for the appropriation of those sums for the specified purposes, in conformity with the Constitution.

A. D. 2009            Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:-

Short title.                    1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (No. 2 for 2009) Act 2009.

Issue from the Consolidated Fund authorised.                    2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund of such sums, not exceeding in the aggregate the gross of four billion, six hundred and seventy-seven million, two hundred and eight thousand, four hundred and five dollars (\$4,677,208,405), necessary to meet the expenditure of Guyana for the fiscal year ending on 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2009, is hereby authorised in accordance with article 219 of the Constitution and sections 24 and 41 of the Fiscal Management and Accountability Act 2003.


