SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION (No. 3 for 2005) BILL 2005

ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS

SECTION

1. Short title.
2. Issue from the Consolidated Fund authorized.
3. Appropriation.

Schedule

A BILL
Intituled

AN ACT to provide for the issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sums necessary to meet the expenditure (not otherwise lawfully charged on the Consolidated Fund) of Guyana for the fiscal year ending 31st December, 2005, estimates whereof have been approved by the National Assembly, and for the appropriation of those sums for the specified purposes, in conformity with the Constitution.

A.D. 2005 Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:-

Short title. 1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (No. 3 for 2005) Act 2005.

Issue from the Consolidated Fund authorized. 2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund of such sums, not exceeding in the aggregate the gross of five billion, three hundred and thirty million, six hundred and eight thousand, five hundred and forty-one dollar (\$5,330,608,541), necessary to meet the expenditure of Guyana for the fiscal year ending on 31st December, 2005, is hereby authorised in accordance with article 219 of the Constitution and sections 24 and 41 of the Fiscal Management and Accountability Act 2003.

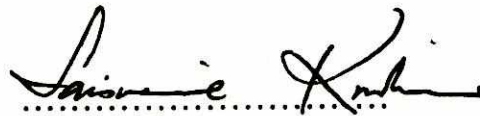
