1. This Act, which amends the Interpretation and General Clauses Act, may be cited as the Interpretation and General Clauses (Amendment) Act 1992 and shall come into operation on 29th March, 1992.

2. Section 38(1) of the Principal Act is hereby amended by the substitution for the word "three" of the word "four".

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend the Interpretation and General Clauses Act, Cap. 2:01, to provide for the standard time of Guyana to be four hours behind Greenwich Mean Time.
