AN ACT to amend the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.

# A.D. 1994

Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:-

### Short title and commencement. Cap; 51:02

1. This Act, which amends the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act, may be cited as the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Amendment) Act 1994 and shall come into operation on the 7th March, 1994.

#### Amendman of section 5A of the Principal Act:

- 2. Section 5A (9) of the Principal Act is hereby amended in the following respects
  - (i) in paragraph (a), by the insertion, after the words "a new", of the words "or used";
  - (ii) in paragraph (b), by the insertion, after the words "into Guyana,", of the words "not being a used motor vehicle to which paragraph (a) applies.".

## EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend subsection (9) of section 5A of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act, Cap. 51:02, so as to apply paragraph (a) of that subsection to used motor vehicles which are the subject matter of a purchase from a dealer in motor vehicles.
