1. Short title and commencement.
2. Repeal and re-enactment of section 8 of the Principal Act.

AN ACT to amend the Extra-Mural Work Act.

1. This Act, which amends the Extra-Mural Work Act, may be cited as the Extra-Mural Work (Amendment) Act 1998 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 9th May, 1998.

2. Section 8 of the Principal Act is hereby repealed and the following section substituted therefor —

Orders.

8. The Minister may by order prescribe —

- (a) the classes of offenders that may be excluded; and
- (b) the areas of Guyana to which this Act shall not apply.

and subject to any order that may be made under paragraph (a) or (b) the provision of this Act shall apply to all offenders under section 3 and to the whole of Guyana.”

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The Bill repeals and re-enacts section 8 of the Extra-Mural Work Act, Cap. 11:02, to provide that the Act shall apply to all offenders within the contemplation of section 3 of the Act and to the whole Guyana, unless the Minister makes an order excluding certain classes of offenders and limiting the areas of Guyana to which the Act shall apply. This amendment is necessary as no subsidiary legislation has been made under this Act and the magistrates utilisation of the provisions of this Act is of doubtful validity.
