Introduction

The Ethnic Relations Commission (ERC) is a Constitutional body established by Constitution (Amendment) (No.2) Act No.11 of 2000 which amends Article 212 D of the Constitution to provide for the establishment of the Commission.

The genesis of the ERC lies in the Herdmanston Accord signed on January 17, 1998, that provided for the establishment of a Constitutional Reform Commission (CRC).

The CRC in its Report to the National Assembly on July 17, 1999, recommended that the Constitution shall establish an adequately funded, suitably broad-based Ethnic Relations Commission (ERC) comprising representatives of religious bodies, labour movement, the private business sector, youth and women. On March 8, 2002, the ERC was established and became operational thereafter.

In accordance with the Constitution of the Cooperative Republic of Guyana, as outlined in Article 212M. (1) '...Commission shall submit to the National Assembly an annual report of the activities of the Commission..." The Ethnic Relations Commission has prepared its Annual Report 2022 to be laid before the National Assembly.

The departmental reports were prepared by the staff that held the positions at the end of Dec. 2022 and in October 2023 the current Heads of Departments edited the same, for structure and grammatical content, and the reports were subsequently reviewed and complied with by the Chief Executive Officer.

The ERC Annual Report 2022 was reviewed by the new Board of Commissioners in October 2023 and adopted at the 6th Statutory Meeting on 26 October, 2023.

Executive Summary

The Ethnic Relations Commission commenced the year 2022 in the absence of a Board of Commissioners. The work of the secretariat was therefore limited, as many decisions required the attention of a Board. However, despite the absence of the Board, the staff conducted their daily duties to keep the Secretariat of the Commission functioning. The Commission started the year 2022 with twenty-two (22) staff members. The year 2022 concluded with twelve (12) staff members, due to the end of contractual periods and one resignation.

The Secretariat of the ERC is divided into 5 Departments, namely Administrative Unit, Finance, Public Education and Awareness Unit, Media Monitoring Unit, and Investigative Unit, which function with the oversight of the Chief Executive Officer.

In 2022 the Public Education and Awareness Unit continued to spread awareness about the ERC, mainly through online mediums. In addition, the Unit participated in a number of Exhibitions to display the work of ERC over the years.

The Media Monitoring Unit during the year in review, detected numerous instances of ethnically/racially offensive comments, with the potential to cause ethnic divisions in the society to the websites and Facebook pages of local media houses, internet television and political parties. The department made a total of 47 interventions on behalf of the ERC to post 'Advisories' warning violators of their breaches.

For the year 2022, the Investigative Unit brought forward one hundred and forty-two (142) complaints from previous years, three of which were before the courts and were subsequently discontinued in the requisite courts and received seven (7) official complaints. Notably there were numerous walk-in and telephone complainants, however as a disclaimer ERC staff advised that 'complaints will only be investigated when the Board of Commissioners were in place, to hire the technical staff and take necessary action' as such those complaints were not lodged.

The Administrative and Finance Units supported the operational functioning of the Secretariat and where possible extended assistance to other departments in the absence of adequate staff.

THE ADMINISTRATIVE UNIT

About the department

The functions of the Administrative Unit are established in the Commission's Human Resources and Procedural Manual as last amended in October 2020. The department's functions are to ensure that all vehicles, furniture, equipment, and office space are maintained to the highest standards. The department ensures that all meeting spaces are meticulously organized.

Additionally, the Department also has the responsibility for all personnel matters for staff employed by the Commission, among other duties which are outlined in this report.

ANNUAL LEAVE

Due to the exigencies of the Commission and in the absence of a Board of Commissioners, the Chief Executive Officer, the Assistant Finance Officer, the Senior Accounts Clerk, and Special Assistant were unable to fully utilize their Annual Leave, as they were performing several roles outside of their portfolios. Consequently, those staff stated above were paid in lieu of the unutilized portion. All other staff members utilized their vacation leave for 2022.

ATTENDANCE

Attendance under the year in review was acceptable.

PERFORMANCE

Despite the Commission's indeterminate state, the staff's commitment remains unfaltering.

COMFORT

Despite, the Secretariat's use of furniture inherited from BIDCO and others acquired throughout the years, the Administration unit has best maintained the furniture in the absence of being able to procure new ones. Shortly, much of the furniture would become unusable, and new ones would become indispensable.

COVID-19 MEASURES

During January 2022, the Commission was forced to close its doors for ten (10) days (January 17 to 27) as a result of the COVID-19 outbreak in the Commission. Likewise, in October the Secretariat was closed once again for nine days (October 25 to November 2) due to staff testing positive. The decision to close was made since the office stations are shared and clustered together therefore transmittal of COVID was high. All staff who did not test positive were required to work from home during the periods and some were periodically required to physically report for duty due to the exigencies of the Secretariat.

During the periods of closure, the office was fumigated by the Ministry of Public Health (MOPH).

COVID-19 measures are still in place in keeping with the MOPH Guidelines.

UNIFORMS

Staff members were not issued with the customary uniforms due to the absence of a Board of Commissioners.

OPERATIONS

EQUIPMENT

The Commission commenced the year with all staff members having the necessary equipment to effectively execute the Commission's work.

The generator, photocopier, and air conditioning units were maintained throughout the year.

The photocopier was serviced on November 24, 2022. The pickup rollers, feed rollers, separation rollers, and drum unit were also replaced. In the future, there will be a need to change the fixing assembly within the copier.

The AC units located in the CEO's Office and the Finance Department require replacement.

The computer system for the Special Assistant to the Chairman, Administrative Clerk I, and Programme Officers needs upgrading. The systems that are not in use would require repairing and possible upgrades over time.

PROCUREMENT

During the year the Commission did not procure any capital item.

VEHICLES

The Commission has a total of four working vehicles. PRR 1131 (Grey Navara 4x4-Automatic transmission); PMM 5053 (Grey Nissan Frontier-Stick gear); PZZ 3533 (URVAN Minibus-Stick gear) and PYY 6352 (Nissan X-Trail-Automatic transmission).

Vehicle PNN 1641, a Toyota Hiace Minibus with an automatic transmission acquired on December 29, 2010, is not working.

A battery was purchased and installed in the Nissan X-Trail PYY 6352.

A new battery was purchased and installed in the Nissan Frontier, however, the vehicle which was due for servicing was not done due to the unavailability of funds.

The bus PZZ 3533 was serviced on June 21, 2022, by Massy Industries, and its air-conditioning unit was fixed.

BUILDING

General maintenance of the building continued as a matter of priority. In September 2022, a leakage was evident and affected the middle wall that separates the Finance Office from the Registry. It was the second occasion in which heavy rainfall would have caused a leakage, which penetrated through the flooring and into the ceilings of the middle floor. As such immediate work was conducted on the specific spot of the roof to cease the leaking.

Leaking in and around the building continues. It is recommended that the roof be fully serviced to avoid such instances in the future.

The fire escape was re-painted and missing louvers windowpanes on the second floor and security hut were replaced.

Fumigation continued by Vector Control as was necessary throughout the year.

SECURITY

The Security Contract (RK's Security Services) which came to an end effective January 2021 was extended every quarter by the National Procurement and Tender Administration Board (NPTAB) until October 31, 2022.

The Secretariat re-advertised the provision of security services upon the advice of the National Procurement and Tender Administration Board (NPTAB). The invitation for bids was advertised in the print media ten (10) times. The first advertisement was placed on Sunday, August 14, 2022, and concluded on Friday, September 2, 2022. The invitation for bids was also uploaded on the ERC's Facebook page.

The bids were opened on September 6, 2022, by NPTAB. The award was made to, Sheriff Security Inc., commencing November 1, 2022. The Service provider thus far has provided acceptable security services.

PREPARATION OF ANNUAL REPORTS

The Secretariat, in keeping with its obligation, submitted its Annual Reports to the Speaker of the National Assembly, for dissemination to all Members of Parliament, on Friday, July 15, 2022. The number of reports submitted is as follows:

- 2. Annual Report 2010 one hundred and twenty hard copies
- 3. Annual Report for the years 2011-2017 thirty hard copies

The Annual Reports were laid in Parliament on Thursday, July 21, 2022.

AUDIT BY THE AUDIT OFFICE OF GUYANA

The Audits into the accounts of the ERC for the fiscal years 2018, 2019, 2020, and 2021 were completed by the Audit Office in keeping with Section 74 of the Fiscal Management and Accountability Act No. 20 of 2003.

Administrative Unit SWOT Analysis

Strengths (strong areas to build upon)

- 1. The Administrative Unit supported the duties of other departments that were not staffed.
- 2. Developed other skill sets on the job, while assisting other departments.
- 3. Good working relations and cooperation among staff.

Weaknesses (issues that affected work)

- 1. Due to the lack of staffing, a few staff were unable to use their annual leave fully.
- 2. There were several urgent building maintenances that were undertaken.
- 3. Unusable furniture could not been replaced in the period under review.
- 4. Security of tenure amongst staff due to the absence of a Board of Commissioners.

Opportunities (areas for improvement)

- 1. In 2022 two staff members were able to undergo training to enhance their skill set.
- 2. The period provided staff to acquire the knowledge and experience of other staff members as they were given additional duties to perform.

Threats (external circumstances that affected work)

1. The effects of COVID-19 affected the Secretariat.

Recommendations

For the period under review, I hereby recommend the following:

- 1. Purchasing of new furniture and equipment to facilitate the new staff that are expected.
- 2. Fixing the roof as a matter of priority.
- 3. Disposal of all unserviceable and damaged equipment and furniture.

FINANCE

Financial Summary

The Ethnic Relations Commission received a voted provision of One Hundred and Seventy-One Million, Four Hundred and Eighty-Two Thousand, and Two Hundred and Fifty-Two Dollars (\$171,482,252.00) for recurrent expenditure 2022.

The amount received from the Ministry of Finance for the period January to December 2022 was Ninety-Four Million, One Hundred and Sixty-Seven Thousand, and Two Hundred and Thirty-Seven Dollars (\$94,167,237.00). The total expenditure for the same period was Ninety Million, Three Hundred and Twenty-One Thousand, and Nine Hundred and Seventeen Dollars (\$90,321,917.00). Hence the amount of Three Million, Eight Hundred and Forty-Five Thousand, and Three Hundred and Twenty Dollars (\$3,845,320.00) was refunded to the Ministry of Finance. There was no capital provisioned.

The ERC 2022 Budget did not cater for any capital allocations.

PUBLIC EDUCATION AND AWARENESS UNIT

Summary

This department report provides an overview of the work done in 2022 by the Public Education and Awareness Unit, (PEAU) of the Ethnic Relations Commission (ERC).

In the absence of a Board of Commissioners and with the lockdown and distancing measures occasioned by the COVID-19 pandemic still in place at the beginning of 2022, the Unit was unable to plan and execute any major events or community outreaches to spread the awareness and mandate of the ERC.

The Unit also experienced staff attrition in 2022 which hampered its functioning. The tenure of three staff members ended, leaving a void.

Nevertheless, the PEAU was able to explore pertinent information available on the internet and devise a work plan for promoting ethnic harmony on social media. At that point in time, social media experienced an upsurge in activity due to many persons working and operating from home.

Notwithstanding the challenges outlined above, the Unit was also able to take part in two external events. The first was the launch of the 2022 Population and Housing Census in August and observances to mark International Human Rights Day on December 10th.

Those events took place in tandem with the gradual removal of restrictions associated with the waning COVID-19 pandemic.

Moreover, work proceeded internally as the Unit was tasked with retrieving, reviewing, and compiling several of its concluded annual reports from previous years that are kept at the Secretariat. Those reports were submitted to the Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs and Governance.

This would have been a challenge if regular public interactions were occurring. The prevailing atmosphere created openings for assessments to be done of past activities of the Unit. It also provided opportunities to review and update existing information for later reference.

Events

The Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs and Governance in recognition of International Day of Human Rights held an Expo on the 10th of December 2022 at the Arthur Chung Conference Center (ACCC) under the theme, Equal Rights for one Guyana. The ERC took part in this event, which was well attended. A booth was set up by the PEAU where visitors were sensitized on the work, mandate and functions of the ERC. Moreover, two hundred information kits, consisting of ERC pamphlets, tokens and a copy of its harmony colouring book were distributed at the Expo.

Public Relations Activities

Social Media

In March, a daily staple of postings to the Commission's Facebook page began which comprised various features to stimulate interest as well as promote tolerance and understanding (see appendix).

Quotes attributed to various eminent personalities the world over, examples of the Guyanese multiethnic cuisine, photos of places, proverbs - all reflecting things Guyanese, and events/developments reminiscent of the country's past were among the daily features since postings began. Messages in support of national observances were also featured on the ERC Facebook page.

Mainstream Media

The ERC sees the media fraternity as a major stakeholder and understands the importance, value and reach that comes with engaging with them to bring awareness to the work and presence of the Commission. Notwithstanding the challenges mentioned earlier, the Unit sought coverage for the dissemination of information to commemorate national observances and messages in support of harmony and the country's diversity. A total of twelve (12) press releases were issued for the year in review.

LEGAL & INVESTIGATIVE UNIT

Overview

The Ethnic Relations Commission has, under Article 212 D of the Constitution of the Co-operative Republic of Guyana, a mandate to receive and investigate complaints of racial/ethnic discrimination, alleged to have been suffered in accordance to the Racial Hostility Act and Representation of the People's (Amendment) Act.

However, effective April 23, 2021, the Secretariat was without a Board of Commissioners, hence, the work of the Unit had been affected by the lack of staff due to the expiration of employment contracts.

The Unit conducted no investigation for the year. Nevertheless, complaints received for the year in review have been filed and will be presented to the new Board of Commissioners once established. Complainants were informed that their complaints could not have been investigated due to the Secretariat's limitations.

LEGAL & INVESTIGATIVE UNIT

Staffing

Mr. Aidan Sparman, Head of the Investigative Unit acting, was the lone staff of the department at the start of 2022, his contractual employment came to an end on March 10, 2022. All other staff of the unit contracts came to an end in 2021 and in the absence of a Board of Commissioners there were no renewals.

The Unit's work was handed over to Ms. Oma Devi Sukhu, Special Assistant to the Chairman. Ms. Sukhu, in the role of Special Assistant, previously supported the work of the Unit, hence was familiar with the complaints process.



COMPLAINTS ANALYSIS

In the year 2022, the Investigative Unit brought forward one hundred and forty-two (142) complaints. **See Annex D for Complaints Matrix**. Three of which were before the courts, however the matters were discontinued in the requisite courts.

The Secretariat received seven (7) official complaints for the year in review. Additionally, the Secretariat would have had in excess of one hundred complaints via walk-ins and telephone calls. However, once a complaint was notified of the Secretariat's limitations to investigate and take immediate action due to the absence of the Board of Commissioners, they were no longer interested in officially filing their complaints.

Media Monitoring Unit

1.0 Executive Summary:

The Media Monitoring Unit (MMU), in pursuit of the Ethnic Relations Commission's mandate to promote ethnic harmony and good relations between and amongst all citizens of Guyana, scrutinizes information communicated through the mainstream media (i.e., Television and Newspapers), and the Internet. The Unit monitors content for infractions of the *Racial Hostility Act* (1964) and *Representation of the People (Amendment) Act*. The ERC established the MMU on 1st February 2011 with the intention to boost the Commission's institutional capacity to monitor the country's mainstream print and broadcast media and all other forms of media (including the Internet).

Operationally, the Unit comprises two (2) sections – a media monitoring section and an election monitoring section. The media monitoring section of the Unit operates on a permanent basis, while the elections monitoring section is temporal and is activated seasonally to coincide with General and Regional Elections (constitutionally due every 5 years) and Local Government Elections (biannually).

Over time, the MMU has created and maintained its own archive of media information which can be used for research purposes, and which can also be easily accessed for reference, if and whenever complaints or allegations of ethnic discrimination/racism are received by the Ethnic Relations Commission from concerned members of the public, aggrieved individuals or any organization which perceives that it has been ethnically/racially profiled in a negative way through the media.

Over the course of the past year (2022), in carrying out our monitoring activities in pursuit of that mandate the Unit was able to achieve the following:

- The recording, monitoring and archiving of over **1600** hours of television programming with political content from 11 television stations broadcasting within Region 4.
- The monitoring and archiving of all the daily and Sunday newspapers i.e. Guyana Chronicle, Guyana Times, Stabroek News and Kaieteur News that were produced during the period 01/01/22 31/12/22.
- Detected and brought to the attention of the ERC forty-seven (47) instances of ethnically/racially offensive comments, with the potential to cause ethnic divisions in the society, posted for interminable periods to the websites and Facebook pages of local media houses, internet television and political parties.
- Made a total of **47** interventions on behalf of the ERC to post 'Advisories' on the websites and Facebook (FB) pages of local media houses, internet television and political parties guilty of allowing ethnically offensive comments that were in violation of the *Representation of the People Act, Chapter 1:03* to remain for protracted periods on their platforms.

2.0 Objectives of the MMU:

- 1. To monitor the local media for adherence to the tenets of the Racial Hostility Act 1964 and Representation of the People (Amendment) Act (2001).
- 2. To bring to the attention of the Chairman and Commissioners of the ERC, any observed infractions of the Racial Hostility Act (1964) and Representation of the People (Amendment) Act (2001), by the print and broadcast media or by any citizen using a public space to influence public opinion.
- **3.** To evaluate complaints sent to the ERC by members of public and organizations, and offer advice accordingly on the merits/demerits of same.
- **4.** To influence a high level of sensitivity and decorum as it relates to the discussion/propagation of ethnic/race issues in public spaces.
- **5.** To promote the maintenance of the highest professional and ethical standards by local media practitioners in their communication of ethnic/race issues to the general public.
- **6.** To make a measurable input into the realization of a peaceful social environment, by actively contributing to the minimization of incidences of dissemination of racism (in all its forms) through the media and/or in campaign rallies/meetings during elections periods.

3.0 Report on Television and Newspapers:

The MMU is pleased to report that for the period January to December, 2022, our monitoring of the country's television stations domiciled in Region 4, did not detect any infringements of the *Racial Hostility Act (1964)* or *Representation of the People (Amendment) Act.* In fact, in the process of carrying out their daily monitoring duties, staff of the Unit would have watched more than **1600** hours of programming over the past year, and in so doing scrutinized a variety of program types such as news, talk-shows, political parties sponsored programs, press conferences, magazine programs and vox-populis, but, outside of a few borderline cases, did not find any program in breach of the aforementioned statutes.

In like manner, the MMU's daily monitoring of the country's four (4) newspapers over the past year, did not turn up any infringements of the aforementioned Acts in the information disseminated to the public through these media sources.

4.0 Report on Social Media:

4.1 Overview

Ever since the MMU began monitoring social media on behalf of the ERC (in 2019), specific focus has been directed at the official websites and Facebook pages of those local media houses and political parties known to be domiciled and operating within the geographical boundaries of Guyana.

Monitoring of social media on behalf of the ERC is done by the MMU in an attempt to curb the increasing use of social media to foment racial divisions in the country and to dissuade persons by way of 'Cautionary Statements' against posting racially inciting/ inflammatory, divisive, stereotypical and hateful comments to the comments sections of the aforementioned websites and Facebook pages. 'Cautionary statements' serve to advise persons of the penalties that can be leveraged against them in a competent Court-of-Law as spelt out in the *Racial Hostility Act* (1964) and the *Representation of the People Act, Chapter 1:03*. Over the past year, the MMU, on behalf of the Commission, posted 'cautionary messages' against comments or into discussion 'threads' that crossed over the line from democratic free speech into language promoting ethnic hate, divisiveness, stereotyping and incitement.

4.2 MMU Findings

In 2022 through our monitoring activities on social media, the MMU was able to detect and bring to the attention of the ERC forty-seven (47) instances of ethnically offensive comments that were contrary to the *Racial Hostility Act* (1964) and the *Representation of the People Act, Chapter 1:03*. These comments were posted to the websites and Facebook pages of local media houses, branded internet television webcasts, and political parties. The comments posted generally fell into four (4) categories of commentaries, viz: racially inciting, racially divisive, racially hateful and racial stereotyping. On **four** (4) occasions during the year, the Unit's staff had grounded reasons to intervene on social media (Facebook) to flag comments that were racially inciting; **thirteen** (13) instances where the comments were racially divisive; **ten** (10) instances where the comments were racially hateful; and, **twenty** (20) times when comments were found to be racially stereotypical (see Appendix 3).

The Facebook sources from where these comments were taken are as follows (in no particular order): News Source Guyana, HGP Nightly News, Newsroom Guyana, Demerara Waves Online News, INews Guyana, Guyana Chronicle, Stabroek News, Village Voice News, 9 Newsbreak, Guyana Daily News (see Appendix 1).

5.0 MMU SWOT Analysis

Strengths

Despite the absence of a Commission during the period under review, the MMU was able to inject 'Cautionary Statements' in the comments sections of websites and social media pages of political parties and media houses, given that it was already empowered by the ERC to make such

interventions. It is apt to reiterate that there were forty-seven (47) instances of ethnically offensive comments that were responded to by the Unit.

Weaknesses

It is to note that the work of the MMU was severely restricted from the beginning of the year and throughout, from staff attrition, due to the expiration of staff members' contracts, in the absence of a Board. As such, the Unit was hardly able to monitor, as was expected, much of the television and internet programs with strong political content. In fact, for the most part of 2022, the Unit's primary concentration was on the daily and Sunday newspapers and the comments sections of the local media's Facebook pages.

Opportunities

Given the likelihood of the body being reconstituted in 2023, the Commission will be able to restaff the Monitoring Unit which will greatly assist the ERC in employing measures to curtail ethnically offensive content from being circulated on social media. With the impending Local Government Elections of 2023, the Commission can also draw from the skill set of already trained elections monitors who can be contracted and deployed to cover public meetings and rallies that the various political parties and groups will hold during the campaign period.

Threats

With the expansion and growth of digital media, more users will be added to social media platforms, but the MMU's staff size constraint is likely to further limit broad-based and holistic monitoring of online content. As such, this situation can be categorized as worrying since the majority of infringements emanate from social media. Moreover, if this condition persists into 2023, there will be an increased likelihood of the Commission being unable to duly address violations to the Racial Hostility Act (1964) and Representation of the People (Amendment) Act, Chapter 1:03.

During 2022, the MMU's role as the ERC's media 'watchdog' though restricted by circumstances beyond our control was, despite the known challenges, a productive one, based on the number of infractions of the *Racial Hostility Act* (1964) and *Representation of the People (Amendment) Act*, the Unit was able to detect on social media and bring to the attention of the Chief Executive Officer of the Commission. Hopefully, with the coming on Board of a new Commission in 2023, the Unit will be re-staffed and revitalized to continue to give active organizational support to the ERC in its effort to ensure that the media is not used as a divisive tool to undermine the Commission's efforts to foster ethnic harmony and good relations in Guyana.

Despite the constraints faced the Secretariat was still able to conduct public awareness activities and engagements, monitor the various media platforms for instances of ethnic and racial discrimination and receive complaints made to the Commission.

In the absence of the Board of Commissioners for the year under review, recommendations for Parliament are not being presented in this ERC Annual Report 2022.




Figure 1: Percentage of ethnic violations found on the Facebook pages of media houses and internet television (2022)




Figure 2 shows the percentage breakdown of ethnic violations on Facebook pages of media houses and Internet television in 2022




Figure 1 shows the number of MMU interventions on social media by month




Figure 2: Pie chart reflects the percentage breakdown of MMU interventions on social media




Figure 1 shows categorized descriptions of ethnically offensive comments




Figure 2 shows the percentage breakdown of categorized ethnically offensive comments


