

## NOTICE

Issued Under

SECTION 4 OF THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS  
(NOT BENEFICIALLY OCCUPIED) ACT 1984

(No. 2 of 1984)

WHEREAS I have reason to believe that the land described in the Schedule is not beneficially occupied:

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 4 (1) of the Acquisition of Lands (Not Beneficially Occupied) Act 1984 (No. 2 of 1984) I hereby declare by this notice that, if such land is not beneficially occupied by the construction thereon of a residential building and the occupation of such building, within a period of six months from the date of this notice, the aforesaid land will be compulsorily acquired by the State under the aforesaid Act.

As ascertained by reasonable efforts the owner of the said land is Lennox Charles et alior, whose last known place of residence is 185 Waterloo Street, in the City of Georgetown, Guyana.
