| Citation | 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Widows and Orphans' Fund (Directors Election) Regulations. |
| Annual election by contributors of two persons other than public officers as directors. | <p>2. (i) The Chairman of the Directors of the Widows and Orphans' Fund shall, not later than the 14th May in each year cause a notice to be published in the Gazette and one newspaper fixing a day and hour for the election of two persons other than public officers to be Directors of the said Fund.</p> <p>(ii) The election shall be not less than six and not more than ten days after the day on which such notice is first published, and shall be held at such convenient place in Georgetown as the Chairman may appoint.</p> <p>(iii) Every contributor registered in accordance with the provisions of the Widows and Orphans' Pension Act shall be entitled to vote at any such election.</p> <p>(iv) The two persons other than public officers having the greatest number of votes shall be deemed to be elected, provided that not less than twenty-five per cent of the registered contributors vote at the election.</p> |
| Mode of voting at election | <p>3. (i) Contributors shall record their votes in writing.</p> <p>(ii) Contributors who attend the place of election may record their votes between the hours of 9 to 11 a.m. and 1 to 3 p.m. in a book to be kept by the secretary for that purpose.</p> <p>(iii) A contributor who does not attend at the place of election may vote according to the form in the schedule signed by him, addressed to the Secretary, and transmitted so as to be delivered at the place of election before 3 o'clock on the afternoon of the day on which the election is held.</p> |
| Declaration and publication of result of voting | 4. (i) The Chairman shall cause the votes to be counted and the names of the persons elected to be declared at the conclusion of the counting. |

- (ii) He shall cause a notice to be published in the Gazette stating the names of the persons elected.
